

### Rules Basics

- Normal Rules, plus:
- The "Zone" is 2 Boat Lengths
- A boat "clear ahead" at the Zone,
  - "owns the zone"
  - Boats clear behind must give her "mark room"
- No penalty betweens boats on the same team, unless there is contact
- One-Turn Penalty
