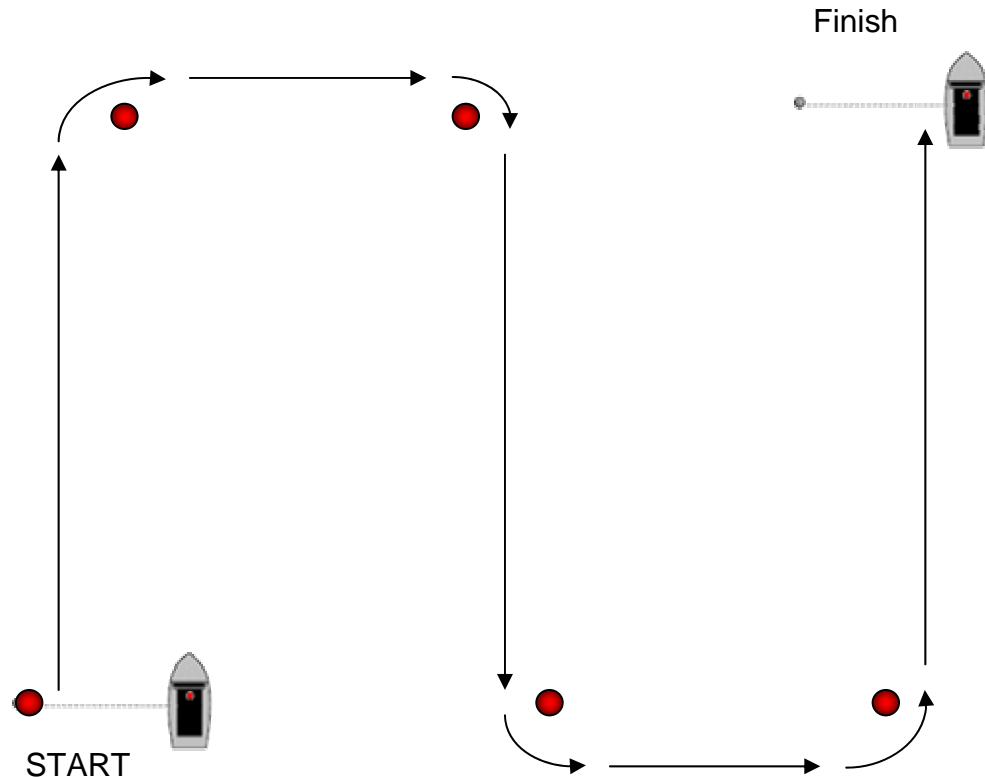

Rules Basics

- Normal Rules, plus:
- The “Zone” is 2 Boat Lengths
- A boat “clear ahead” at the Zone,
 - “owns the zone”
 - Boats clear behind must give her “mark room”
- No penalty between boats on the same team, unless there is contact
- One-Turn Penalty

In consideration of the agreement of Sail Sand Point, to offer use of a boat to me, I agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless Sail Sand Point, the City of Seattle, their advisory council, officers, members, agents, employees and insurers in the event of any accident, damage or injury resulting from my use of said boat. I further agree that I am solely responsible for any expenses incurred due to damage, loss of property or personal injury suffered by Sail Sand Point, members of my party or any third parties, resulting from my use of this boat.
