[^0]Applicable By-law - Voting by mail
Article VII Section 6. Any eligible member who will be unable to attend a membership meeting where nominations and/or by-law amendments or other specific issues are to be voted on may vote by mail. An official ballot containing the names of all the nominees and or other specific issues to be voted on as stated in the notice of the meeting shall be
provided to members. Upon delivery of or mail of said ballot to the club office, the member's name shall be checked on the checklist of members to be used at the meeting. The member shall not receive any other copy of such ballot. Completed ballots, including those returned by mail, shall be deposited in the ballot box which shall remain locked until opened by the Nominations and Elections Committee. This may be mailed or hand delivered to the club. After unlocking the ballot box, the Nominations and Elections Committee shall remove and separate the ballots from the enclosing envelopes and check the names against the Secretary's list.
