Build interest in local team racing through education and training.

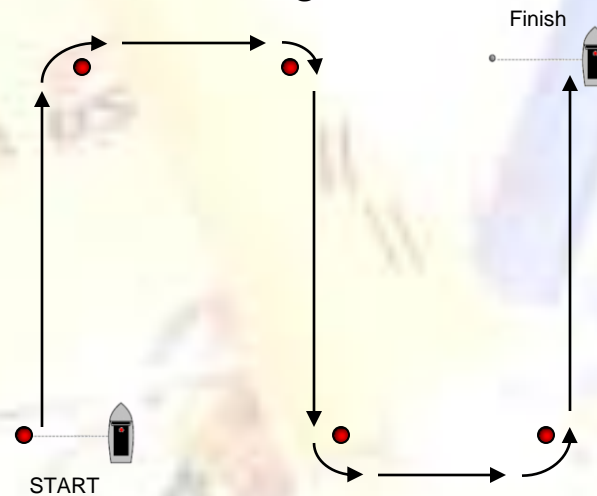
Create a forum which interests sailors of all ages and helps build excitement and enthusiasm for sailboat racing.
